Human growth and development (HG&D) instruction shall be made available to students in the Medford Area Public School District (MAPSD).

MAPSD shall provide the parent(s)/guardian(s) of each student receiving HG&D instruction with a basic outline of curriculum and information on how the parent(s)/guardian(s) may inspect the complete curriculum and instructional materials at any time during regular school office hours.

The parent(s)/guardian(s) of a minor student may withhold their child(ren) from any unit(s) or individual lessons of the curriculum by filing a written request with the principal and/or teacher. In cases where a student will not be participating in all or part of the curriculum, the school will provide the student with alternative assignments of approximately equal difficulty and length. The student shall be graded based on the quality of the alternative assignments.

An advisory committee shall be appointed to develop curriculum and to advise the board of education on the design, review and implementation of such curriculum. The committee shall consist of parent(s)/guardian(s), teachers, administrators, students, health care professionals, members of the clergy and other residents of the school district.

The curriculum shall be evaluated no less than every three years.
